Welcome

The Chairman of the Academic Council, Dr. Binoy Joseph extended a warm welcome to the members including the newly nominated members attending the meeting in the board room and online.

After this the agenda was taken up for discussion.

1) Item No. AC 4.1/1: Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 25th August 2020 (online)

The Chairman presented the minutes of the previous meeting held on 25th, August 2020.

As the members found no issues which needed to be resolved, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved unanimously.

2) Item No. AC 4. 1/2: Report of action taken .

a) Approval of Syllabus of various programmes.

As per the resolution taken in the last meeting of the Academic Council, the revised syllabi of various programmes, along with the proposal for the introduction of new programmes during 2021-22 – BA (Hons.) in English Literature & Journalism, BSW (Hons), MSW with focus on Clinical Social Work, B.Sc (Hons) Psychology M.Sc Counselling Psychology, B.Com (Hons), were submitted to MG University for their approval. We are awaiting the final reply from M.G University.

b) Permanent increase of seats:

Separate applications were submitted to the University for granting permission for the permanent increase of seats in the existing programmes.

c) Renaming of the Department of Personnel Management as Department of Human Resources Management

Consequent to the renaming of MA (PM&IR) programme to MHRM by the University, submission was also made to the University for considering the renaming of the Department of Personnel Management to Department of Human Resources Management in tune with the change of nomenclature of the PG programme conducted by the Department.

It was also informed in the meeting by the Chairman of BOS (HRM) that the M.G. University had constituted an expert committee and the committee recommended to change the nomenclature of the MHRM Programme to MA (HRM) in line with the nomenclature specified by the UGC and awaiting the final approval of M.G. University.

d) Proposal for starting Research Centres

The works for the requisite details for submission of applications for sanctioning Research Centres in the Department of Computer Sciences, Library & Information Sciences and Psychology are going on and the same will be completed for submission to the M.G. University shortly.

The Principal informed the council that notification had been published for appointment of qualified teachers in various departments to strengthen the academic excellence and to make the departments as centres of excellence for promoting research and publications.

The members expressed satisfaction over the report of action taken .

3) Item No. AC 4. 1/3: Reporting of Activities

a) Sanctioning of a new M.Sc Statistics (Aided) programme during 2020-21.

The Government vide its order G.O(Ms)No.389/2020/H.Edn. issued on 5-11-2020, granted permission to conduct M.Sc Statistics programme under aided stream and affiliation order was also issued by M.G. University (order No. 5773/AC A1/2020/MGU dated 5th December 2020) for commencing the programme during the academic year 2020-21

b) Extension of Autonomous Status to the College.

The UGC vide its order No.F.22-1/2017(AC) dated 11th November 2020, granted extension of autonomous status to the college for ten (10) more years from the session 2020-21 to 2029-2030.

c) Re-accreditation of NAAC for the next phase.

The NAAC team for the inspection towards the re-accreditation of the college is expected to visit the college campus in January/February 2021.

d) UGC Scheme for mentoring NAAC accreditation.

The college has already selected five non-accredited colleges under "Paramarsh" scheme for quality enhancement. Now one more college "Rajagiri College of Management & Applied Sciences, Kakkanad" has also been included under the above scheme. We have to work within the fund already allotted by the UGC.

e) Approval of Revised syllabus of B.Com model I and Model II (Finance & Taxation stream)

The M.G. University vide its order No. 40955/AC B7-1/2020/AC B 7 dated 5-11-2020, granted approval to the revised scheme & syllabus of B.Com Model I & II (Finance & Taxation stream) for the Academic Year 2021-22.

f) Approval of Revised syllabus of MCA (2 year) programme

The M.G. University vide its order no. 4702/AC B 7/2020/MGU dated 14-10-2020 granted approval to the revised syllabus of MCA (2 year) programme following the PGCSS Regulation 2019, effective from the Academic year 2020-21. The classes were started as per the revised syllabus.

g) Interchange of core papers of Semester I and III of M.Lib.I.Sc programme from the Academic year 2020-21:

As per the resolution taken in the last meeting of the Academic Council, the proposal for the interchange of core papers of I & III semesters of **M.Lib.I.Sc** was submitted to M.G. university. Now, the MG University vide its order no. 5147/AC B 7/2020/MGU dated 4th November 2020 granted approval for the interchange of core papers of Semester I & III of **M.Lib.I.Sc** programme from the Academic Year 2020-21.

h) Recommendation of "Rajagiri Management Journal" to UGC CARE List

As per the request made by the college for the inclusion of "Rajagiri Management Journal" in the UGC CARE list, the M.G. University has recommended the same for the inclusion in UGC CARE list as it was already included in various databases like Emerald publishing, EBSCO and British Library.

i) Conduct of PG Courses as per MGU PGCSS Regulation 2019

The M.G. University vide its letter dated 30-8-2019 and order no. 1581/AC B 7/2020/MGU dated 16-3-2020, directed the College to follow the MGU PGCSS 2019 Regulations for PG programmes having the same durations, number of credits, evaluation and grading system, with the PG Programmes conducted by the M.G. University.

j) Conduct of various Semester exams.

Steps have been taken to conduct all pending exams from 28th December 2020 and odd semester exams from 3rd week of January 2021.

The chairman in addition to the above explained the different activities carried out since the last meeting. He also informed the council that the date of visit of NAAC team is not yet finalized and their visit is expected by the end of January or in February 2021 and MG University nominees are informed to join on those days. As per the directions of the Government and MG university, the college completed all the pending exams and regular exams are scheduled to be conducted by the third week of January 2021.

(4) Item no. AC 4.1/4 - Suspension of newly sanctioned MSc Statistics programme during 2020-21

The M.G. University granted affiliation to the newly sanctioned M.Sc Statistics programme during the academic year 2020-21. But considering the practical difficulty involved in the successful conduct and completion of the programme during 2020-21, the M.G. University may be requested to grant approval to suspend the programme during 2020-21 and start the same during the next academic year 2021-22.

The MG University nominee expressed his concern about the sanctioning of only one programme by the Government even though the college consistently stood at the highest score in NAAC accreditation. Hence, a separate request may be submitted to MG university and Government of Kerala for sanctioning one more aided programme during this year itself.

Considering the details furnished by the Principal, the council recommended to seek permission from MG University to suspend the MSc Statistics programme during this Academic year and start the same during the next academic year (2021-22)

(5) Item no. AC 4.1/5: Cessation of BLISc Programme

With the introduction of a two year M.Lib.I.Sc programme during 2020-21 as per the UGC Guidelines, the viability for the conduct of BLISc was discussed and it was proposed to cease the BLISc programme from 2020-21 with the permission of the university.

The council resolved to cease the BLISc programme from 2020-21 with the permission of the M.G university.
