Research Proposal 1:

Name of the Presenter: Lorane Scaria

Research Title: Psychosocial predictors of depression among caregivers of people with

disability in a community cohort: Development of social work intervention framework

Comments by the Expert Panel:

The panel decided that the study has no specific ethical issues for the identified target

population. Further suggestions provided include

Caregiving process is significantly influenced by the personality of the Carer and the

nature of the Carer's relationship with the person with a disability.

Adjusting for factors like the nature of the disability, relationship with the Carer, and

other variables affecting the study's outcome are crucial when looking for the

intervention's effectiveness.

Research Proposal 2

Name of the Presenter: Renitta Manuel

Research Title: Rehabilitation and Social Reintegration of Women Probationers in Kerala

Comments by the Expert Panel:

The Committee had a positive response to the presentation. Since the presentation had documented all potential ethical considerations and their management, the committee has approved the same. No further changes were suggested.

Research Proposal 3

Name of the Presenter: Sachu M

Research Title: Prosocial Behaviour among Adolescent boys in Ernakulam district: A Social

Work Intervention Study

Comments by the Expert Panel:

The IEC members gave the ethical clearance with the following suggestions.

The intervention variables need to be specified.

- Normalize the sample/ respondents
- Size of the sample needs to be increased.
- Rework the research design and sampling procedures for the intervention study
- Preparation of research tools (scales) for all the intervention variables

Conclusion: -

The Institutional Ethics Committee was convinced of the Principal Investigators' awareness of the ethical concerns and the necessary steps they have taken related to their studies. The committee approved all three studies' protocols as it has no ethical issues.
