

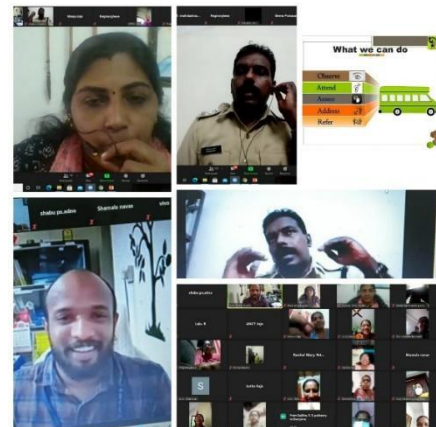

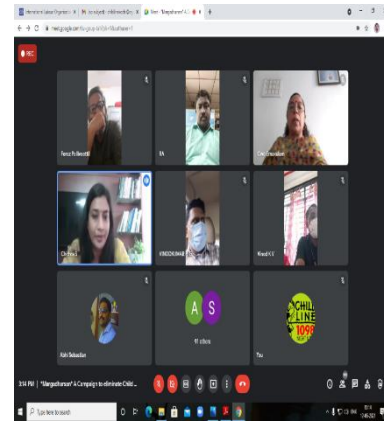


### 2. Margadarshan – Campaign To Eliminate Child Labour

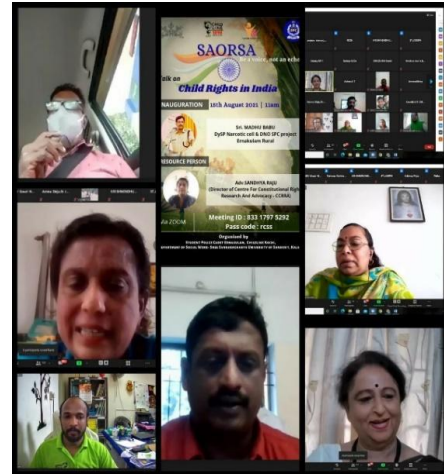
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## 8. Sensitization programme on Childrights in India - August 15

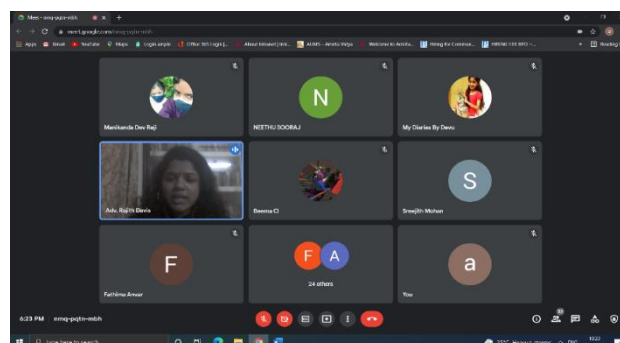


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## 19. WEBINAR ON POCSO AND JJ ACT
