Discussions & Decisions

1. Attainment of the UGC Autonomous Status for the College

The Principal announced the much awaited Autonomy Status granted to the College via UGC letter No.F.22-1/2014 (AC) dated 19th, June, 2014. He also added that the MG University Order for further approval of the UGC Autonomous status is awaited. He also said that a Formal Public Announcement of the Autonomous Status would be made in the presence of the Chief Minister of Kerala at a later date.

2. Actions to be initiated on attaining Autonomy status

Principal mentioned the following actions to be initiated for taking forward the Autonomous Status

- Constitution of Statutory Committees
- A new College logo to be devised
- Curriculum Development where ever need be
- Admission marketing more vibrant to have more diverse students for the new programmes
- Examination wing to be in place with the appointment of Controller of Examinations,
 Asst.Controller of Examinations, Examination Manual, Examination Calendar and setting up
 the office of the Controller of Examinations and a proven software for package for all the
 examination requirements.
- ERPs for Performance Appraisals, admission, student related matters etc to be in place
