CHILDLINE initiated a capacity building programme for CHILDLINE team members on counselling and its methods on 19th July 2018 at RCSS. Prof. Anish, Head, Dept. of social work, RCSS had handled the session.

With the aim to demote the use of plastic kits and promote the use of paper bags, the Institute imparted skill training in Paper Bag Making to the selected 450 households in the 15 wards of Kanjoor Grama

NSS Social Sensitisation camp was conducted at Puthenvelikkara near Saratha

 Camp to focus on demolition of wall for an LP school which would be reconstructed by a
 Delhi based NGO SEEDS which would re-use the broken down bricks and cement blocks
 for the wall construction

•A house was constructed for a flood affected family in Kottapuram by the Department of Social work with the support of College Management.
