Agenda item No.3.AQAR Submission for the year 2018-19

IQAC Coordinator Dr. Mary Venus Joseph informed that as per the Revised NAAC Guidelines for the IQACs dated 26th September, 2019, the HEIs are expected to submit the AQAR after one year from date of Accreditation every year. RCSS was accredited during the month of March.Hence the AQAR for 2018-19 could be submitted only after one year that is in March, 2020.
