Shanbhag, Deputy Adviser, National Assessment And Accreditation Council (NAAC) on 18th, August, 2017, that Extension of the validity period of Accreditation for HEI's, consistently achieving the highest grade in three consecutive cycles

of NAAC accreditation has been decided. As Rajagiri College is fulfilling the conditions, accreditation status is extended for two more years. ie.upto 22/03/2020
