THE RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Care of elderly women, a focus of the decade

The Research Institute is entrusted by the National Commission for Women, Govt. of India, to conduct a study on the Care of Elderly Women in Kerala. The study aims to unearth the present situation of elderly women in the state especially related to the issues they are facing in availing and utilising the existing services. The data will be collected from 540 elderly women, 180 care takers of elderly women and 30 Key personnel from the selected six districts of Kerala.

National Social Organizations & Institutions Meet

A National level Meet of Social Organisations in India on 'Transforming India: Issues, Challenges & Opportuities' was held in connection with the India International Science Festival (IISF) from 14th – 15th October 2017 at CUIC Auditorium, Anna University Campus, Chennai. Dr. Celine Sunny represented the Institute, as a Resource person and spoke about the scope of enriching the varied resources available with the corporate and government sector in implementing the nation building activities.



Workshop for Women on Water, Sanitation and Hygiene

The National Commission for Women, Govt. India has decided to conduct a state level Awareness Generation Workshop for Women in Kerala on 'Water, Sanitation and Hygiene' in association with the Research Institute, RCSS. The aim of the workshop is to disseminate the relevant information on the importance of women's role in the effective utilization of water, sanitation and hygiene facilities. Rural and Urban women comprising housewives, functionaries of non-governmental organizations, house maids, women in the unorganized sector, Kudumbashree members, self employed women, animators, etc. will participate in the programme. The workshop will also act as a forum for the women coming from the different locations of the state to share their views on the subject and the prevailing problems they are facing and to put forward suggestions for enhancing a healthy life style.

Gender Violence in Kerala, a study to expose the pattern and incidence

The Research Institute has conducted a research study on 'Concept, Pattern and Incidence of Gender Violence in Kerala under the sponsorship of Indian Council for Social Science Research (ICSSR). The study covered 1400 women victims of gender violence in public sphere (514).and private sphere (886) from 14 districts of Kerala. The findings of the study highlight the need for more legal literacy campaigns among the women. The lack of awareness regarding the available services meant for them was found to be a major hurdle for the

victims and calls for frequent awareness generation programmes to avail, access and utilize these services. The study further suggests for more counselling centres at local level and shelter homes at district level for the women and children in distress.
