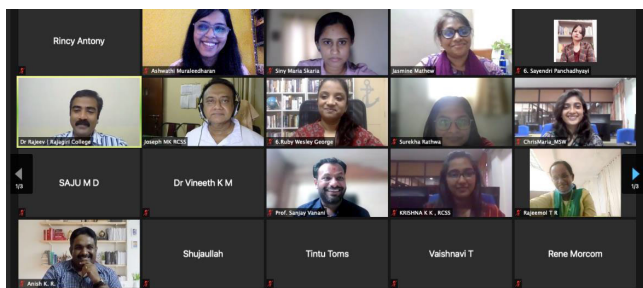

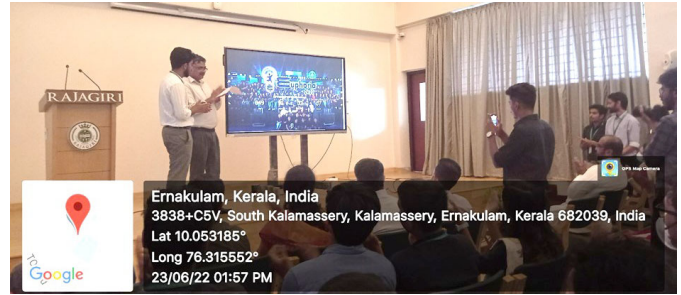
**Training on “IoT Application Development”.**

**National Workshop on “Qualitative Research Methods”**



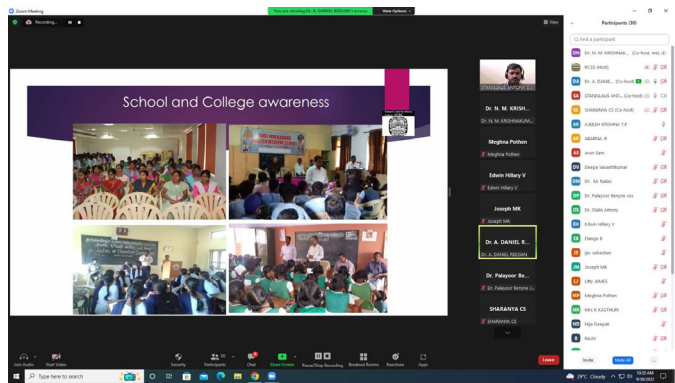
