This was done to develop their creativity, uniqueness and competitive mind. After that we had another management activity of tapping a ball. Then they were told to share their learnings group wise in a way that a group had a scribe and two spoke persons. After that, a mime competition was conducted and each group was given different topics.

The second day begins by sharing the experience of the previous day. A lot of management activities were conducted on this day too. They had a quiz based on the video analysis and interpretation. The students had a group discussion within each group, preceded with a mock group discussion, where different topics were assigned to each group. This has improved their communication skills, thoughts, self-confidence, which will be very helpful for appearing for interviews, placements.

Then they had a brief session about the do's and don'ts of body language while speaking. In the afternoon, they had a small session on the psychology of emotions. Based on the activities done, a champion team was selected and all the students were awarded certificates. With that, the program came to an end and Ms. Swarna Babu delivered the vote of thanks. These two days made huge positive changes on each student and gained a lot of soft skills that will be helpful for their career.

Mpower 2022

Mpower is a personal enhancement training workshop conducted by the Department of Computer Science, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous) for the first semester students. The training spans 4 days every year for a batch. The department of CS has 2 batches of students.
