Day 2:- Practice Research in Social Work Education: Research in action.

Day 3:- Evidence Based Policy and Practice: Practice Research Models in Specific Populations.

Guidelines for Abstract

- Abstract should be within 250-300 words including title and keywords. Abstract must be submitted as Word document, with a covering letter containing the name and designation of the author(s), institution affiliation, mailing address, contact numbers.
- Text should be arranged according to the following headlines: Background, Methodology, Results and Conclusion.
- Abstract need to be uploaded in (google form) on or before July 10th, 2020.
- Full-length research papers are to be submitted (3500 –5000 words) after acceptance of abstract.

Selected papers will be published in the conference proceedings with ISBN.

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
