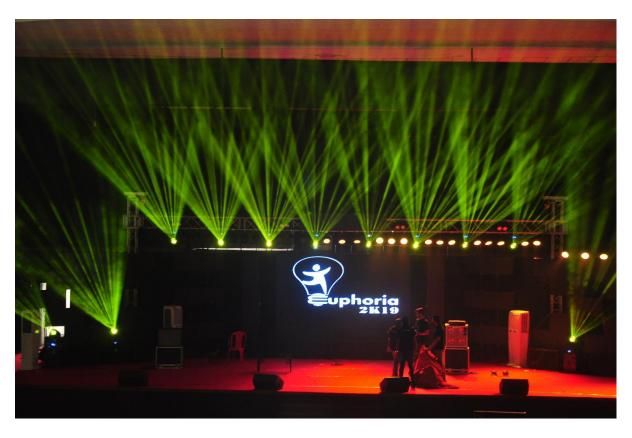
The events that unfolded this year were nothing but excellent as this year's Euphoria 2k19 started off with the "**Green Initiative**". It invited great attention from the media and emphasized how the bio degradable wastes such as old cloths, thrown away bottles and cans, and unused bamboos etc were used to create the decorations for the fest.



Another form of innovation was the development of "**Prof. RED**". A face recognition robot which was developed by **Joseph Philip** of the third year MCA (2017-20). The robot itself was also made using trash materials, bio degradable items and thrown away bottles. Additionally, it was equipped with a computer, a 12MP camera and two speakers. RED is also equipped with hotword detection feature by responding to select keywords such as "Hello Read", "Okay Red" etc. It also has a face recognition feature. So whenever it recognizes the face of a person, it will greet them by calling out the person's name and giving handshake. The robot is programmed using Python 3.6 and Embedded C.



The cultural events along with the technical events did not disappoint. This year the prize money was worth around a whopping **1.5 lakh** which was entirely sponsored by the **Alumni** of Dept. of Computer Science. **Eduomania Overseas Education Consultants** was the Title sponsor, **Club FM** was the media partner. Apart from being the media partner they also cooperated in conducting the **Grihalakshmi Talentum** which was held for the girl students.

RURAL CAMP NIRAV 2K19

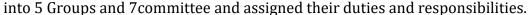
31st August 2019
